If you are receiving this letter you have signed up for the partial class action settlement in this matter and have selected the water filter option.

We estimate the value of this relief per claimant household to be less than \$600 in any year, so you will **NOT** receive a Form 1099. However, the relief may be taxable, and we suggest you discuss with your tax consultant.

The provided water filter is an EVERPURE 4FC-P Filter Cartridge. This filter is designed to remove PFOA/PFOS, chlorine, taste & odor, lead, microplastics and particulates. The filter can filter up to 4000 gallons of water after which the filter should be replaced. It is recommended that you **change the filter yearly**. The settlement will pay for the first filter, but the following **replacement filters are not covered by the settlement**.

The filter is designed to be installed on one sink within your home. **These filters do not and cannot filter the entire home**. Doing so will destroy the filter and could potentially damage your home's water system. The settlement nor Fontis shall be responsible for the damages in such an event.

Fontis Water Inc. is contracted to install the filter for you and help you decide the best location in your home to install the filter. Fontis and the settlement are not responsible for any damages resulting from the removal of the water filter by yourself or an outside party. Fontis may deny the installation of the water filter if there is no suitable place in your home to install the filter. Fontis may also deny installation of the filter if installation would create an undue burden on Fontis. Fontis has complete discretion to make such decision not to install the filter on a case-by-case basis.

If you are denied installation, you may call the settlement to receive the Water Bottle option.
