If you are receiving this letter you have signed up for the partial class action settlement remedy in this matter and have selected the water bottle option.

We estimate the value of this relief per claimant household to be less than \$600 in any year, so you will **NOT** receive a Form 1099. However, the relief may be taxable, and we suggest you discuss with your tax consultant.

The benefit provided today is 5-gallon water bottles sourced from a spring in Blue Ridge, GA. This spring is owned, operated, and maintained by Fontis Water Inc of Marietta, GA. The purpose of this benefit is to provide the users of the city of Summerville with a temporary source of clean drinking water.

The duration of this benefit is **12 months**. The first month you will receive **four** 5-gallon water bottles, and a water bottle stand to dispense the water. The remaining 11 months you will receive **three** 5-gallon water bottles per month. Each month Fontis will only replace empty bottles set out for collection. If you do not set out your empty bottles at the end of the month you will not receive new full bottles.

The water bottle stand may be plugged into a functioning wall outlet to dispense hot and cold water. However, the stand will also work without electricity to dispense the water. The hot and cold functionality will not be enabled without electricity.

It is recommended that you do **not** store full water bottles in direct sunlight. Additionally, do **not** store the water bottles in areas next to expensive or delicate items in case of a leak in the water bottles. Additionally, do **not** set water bottles on delicate flooring or rugs. Please check your full water bottles periodically to ensure they are not leaking. Neither Fontis Water Incorporated nor the Summerville Class Action Settlement will be held responsible for damages resulting from a leaking water bottle.
